

# Pajama Game Information Sheet

## Meetings:

- FIRST Meeting – Thursday, May 5 – 6:00-8:00 PM, Script Read thru- Cast Members
- Parent Meeting @ 6:00 pm – EGHS Auditorium - Mandatory attendance

Rehearsals begin when school lets out. - East Granby High School auditorium. Bring your own snacks (& lunch on full days. Always pack a water bottle, water alleviates spillage problems in the auditorium. All snacks will need to be consumed outside of the auditorium.

CELL PHONES are to be turned off upon entering rehearsal. The director reserves the right to confiscate any cell phones being used during his time. They will be returned at the end of rehearsal.

NO RUNNING in the auditorium at any time! We want everyone to have a safe environment for rehearsing and we all know that school rules **FORBID** running around in the building!

PROPER FOOTWEAR is ALWAYS required in the auditorium at rehearsals. **PLEASE NO BAREFEET**. We have had cast members get splinters from the stage.

## Each family is responsible for the following:

- FEES: \$125 for the first cast member, \$100 each add'l, family max \$325 See payment plan document for details.
- Advertisements: \$100. Every family is responsible for selling or purchasing \$100 in advertisements. Good news: Any family selling **more** than their \$100 obligation may take additional sales off of their fees.
- TICKETS: Each family is responsible for selling 10 tickets. (Adults \$12 at door, \$10 in advance, seniors/children/students-\$7)..Additional advertisements may not be used to purchase tickets. Be guaranteed good seats! Seating is assigned once ALL payments have been completed. Reserved seating begins in the center section of the auditorium.

Three Strikes you're out. **ONCE SCHOOL LETS OUT** you cannot miss more than three rehearsals (unexcused).

- Prior conflicts will be reviewed by the director and assist him in determining roles.
- Conflicts added to the conflict calendar after auditions could jeopardize your casting role.
- Each year we arrange our rehearsals to accommodate most known conflicts. Cast members can not miss rehearsals as it is unfair to the cast who dedicate their time to the show. The director can release a cast member from the show or give your lines to another member.

- **July 21:** Tech week begins, full cast required

- **July 28 and 29** Opening Nights!! (5:00pm call) 7:00 p.m. curtain, EGHS
- **July 30** Matinee Performance!! (12:00 noon call) 2:00 p.m. curtain, EGHS.
